

Our nine week summer camp will run June 26<sup>th</sup> - August 24<sup>th</sup>. We are open Tuesday-Friday from 12:00 pm - 5:30 pm. Children are eligible to attend from the summer before Kindergarten until 18 years of age.

We will serve a free USDA lunch from 12:30-1:00 daily which is open to ages 1-18 years. Snack for Kids Zone members will be served at 3:30.



Our fee for attendance will be divided into need based tiers. Tier 1 members will be charged \$10/day. Tier 2 members will be charged \$5/day; qualification for Tier 2 membership requires enrollment in a state assisted benefit program such as OHP, ERDC, SNAP or TANF. Up to half of Tier 2 member charges may be paid with volunteer service. Children ages 12 will not be charged for attendance.

We are excited to be able to offer one-way transportation to Kids Zone this summer. The bus will leave Taft Elementary and pick children up southbound to Depoe Bay to arrive before lunch is served. Transport home cannot be provided.
